Declaration on the implementation of REACH

Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) entered into force on June 1, 2007.

PC Electric GesmbH does not produce, mix or import any chemical substances and acts as a downstream user in the sense of the REACH regulation.

According to article 33 of the regulation we inform you that the following SVHC substances greater than 0.1% w/w are contained in the articles:

- Lead CAS No. 7439-92-1 in copper alloys (brass) in contacts, terminals and in steel at switch axles
- D6 CAS No. 540-97-6 in silicone O-rings
- DOTE CAS No. 15571-58-1 in rigid PVC and PMMA covers, plates

Our packaging does not contain SVHC substances in the concentrations greater than 0.1% (w/w).

With this letter we refer to the current SVHC list. Updates to the SVHC list are reviewed on an ongoing basis.

We will provide a comprehensive list of affected products for notification to ECHA for compliance with WFD Directive 208/851/EU upon request.

Guidance for safe use: A REACH safety data sheet is not required. Under normal conditions of use it is not expected to pose a significant risk to human health or the environment.

Note: Independently, lead is allowed in copper alloys up to 4% by mass and in steels not exceeding 0.35% by mass according to the RoHS- 2011/65/EU directive. Our products meet these requirements.
