Declaration on the implementation of the WFD Directive


With the adaptation of the Waste Framework Directive 2008/98/EC by Directive (EU) No. 2018/851, it has to be ensured that the supplier of a product, where one or more articles of which it is composed contain an identified SVHC substance in a concentration higher than 0.1 mass percent (w/w) per article, has to provide the information to the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) as of January 5, 2021.

PC Electric GesmbH complies with the National Chemicals Law, which has implemented the WFD Directive.

To help you comply with the notification requirement to ECHA, we are providing you with a detailed XLSX list of affected PCE products.

Our packaging does not contain SVHC substances in the concentrations greater than 0.1% (w/w).

Guidance for safe use: A REACH safety data sheet is not required. Under normal conditions of use it is not expected to pose a significant risk to human health or the environment.
