

To Whom It May Concern

The European REGULATION (EC) No 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 December 2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) entered into force on 1st June 2007. The purpose of this Regulation is to ensure a high level of protection of human health and the environment, including the promotion of alternative methods for assessment of hazards of substances, as well as the free circulation of substances on the internal market while enhancing competitiveness and innovation.

Under REACH, companies operating in the EU face certain obligations as manufacturers, importers and/or downstream users. One of the key requirements is the Duty to Communicate Information on Substances in Articles (Article 33).

This document is to confirm that the products manufactured and/or supplied by Produal Oy have been evaluated against Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 of the European Parliament, "Registration, Evaluation, and Authorization of Chemicals (REACH).

Products and packaging as manufactured and/or supplied by Produal Oy do not contain substances on the REACH SVHC¹ candidate list in concentrations greater than 0.1% by weight per article².

The determination is made at the best of our current knowledge, based on information from our suppliers which we believe are reliable.
